### **2026 Scholarship Opportunities:**

- \$2,500 SSF Scholarship – open to any graduating senior who desires to continue playing tackle football in college. \*
- \$1,250 SSF 'Twelfth Man' Scholarship - open to any graduating senior who has a history of supporting their high school tackle football team (i.e. team manager, trainer, stats-keeper, etc.), and the desire to support athletics in college. \*

\* Special consideration for student-athletes interested in attending / playing at UNLV.

### **Eligibility:**

- Overall High school Grade Point Average of 3.0 or better
- High School Senior Status
- Accepted to a 4-year college or university with the intention to continue their football career or the desire to support athletics in college.
- Nominated by high school coach
- Participated at the Varsity level in football their senior year or served as support personnel for the varsity football team
- Has not accepted any full ride scholarship to participate in college athletics

### **Criteria Nomination:**

- Nomination by Coach
- Academic Achievement
- Demonstration of their pride and passion for Southern Nevada
- Embodiment of the SSF's values

### **Nomination Material:**

- Signed and completed application
- Answer both short-answer questions in 150 words or less (each):
  - Clearly explain how you've demonstrated pride and passion for the Southern Nevada community.
  - Clearly explain what "Commitment to Excellence" means to you.
- Coach's nomination letter

  2. *Clearly explain what 'Commitment to Excellence' means to you.*Answers should be TYPED and saved as a PDF.
  
- Obtain a "Coach's letter of recommendation" (250 words or less) which speaks to the student's qualities which make them a strong candidate for either SSF scholarship.
  
- Submit materials (all together) to the NFF **AND** SSF **no later than noon on April 1, 2026.**  
NOTE: Due to national reporting deadlines, late submissions cannot be accepted.
